Family is the first important agent of Political Socialization. It plays a key role in moulding the character of the child and their attitude towards politics.



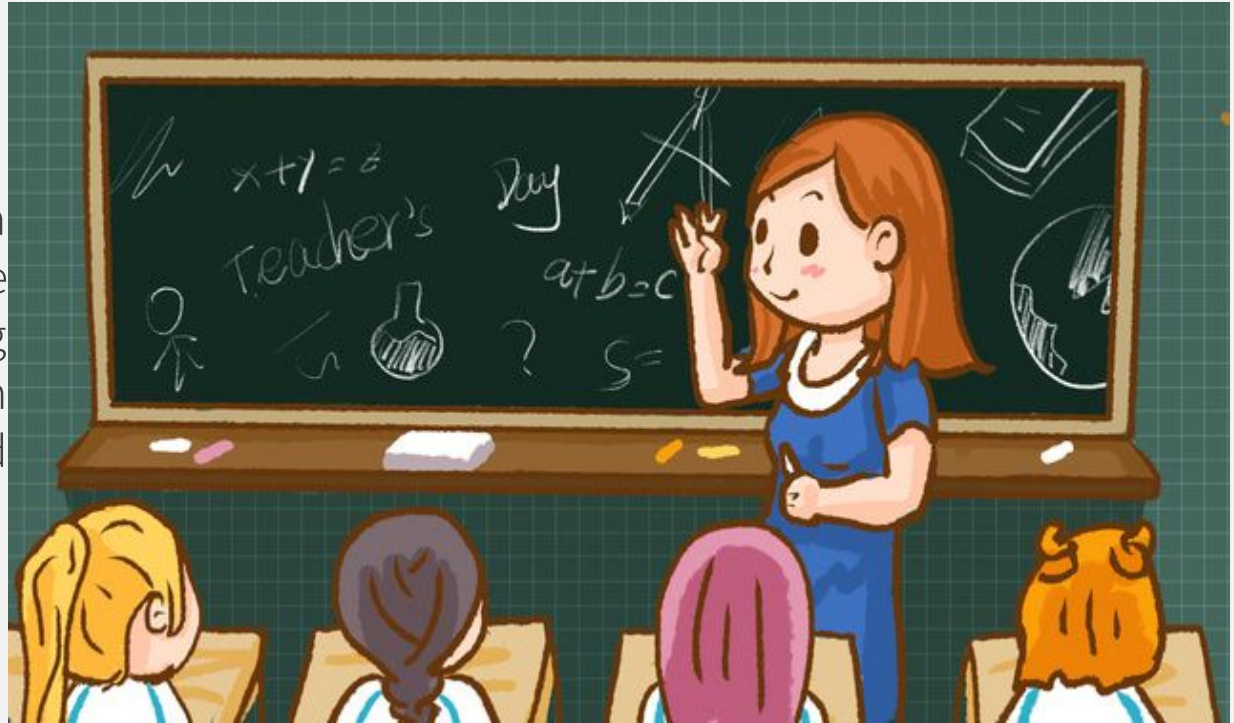
2- Peer groups

School educates children about politics and their role in the process, providing them with information on political institutions and relationships.



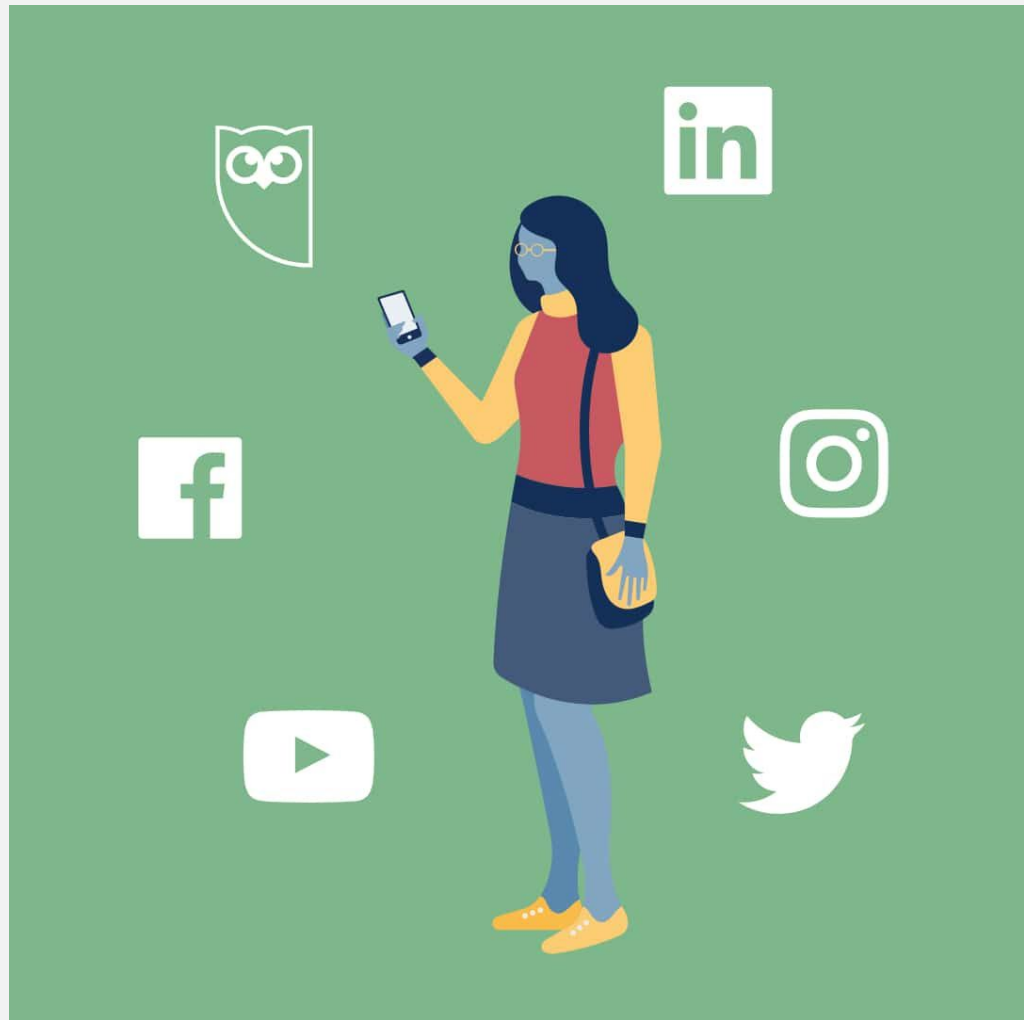
4- Religion
