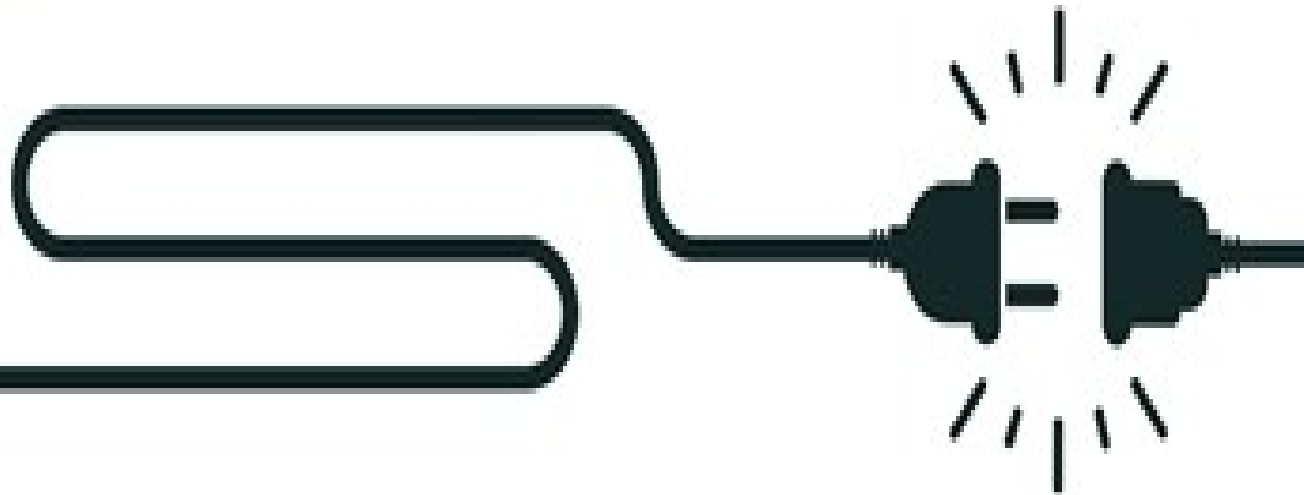
Introduction



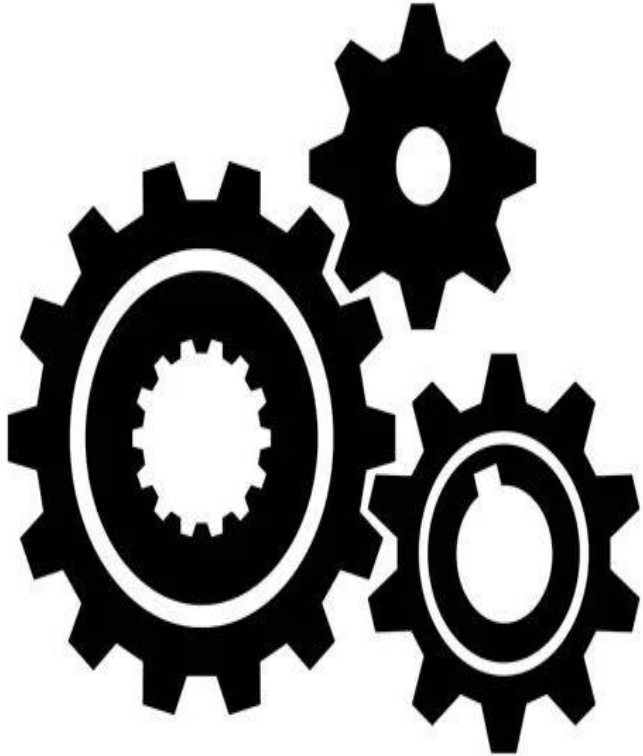
- The mind-reading shopping cart is a useful device for those who think that grocery shopping is a burden.
