Students Representative Guide 2022 / 2021

Vision: Selecting a student to represent the batch in implementation of one of the quality assurance requirements in the participation of stakeholders in the faculty council and committees.

Objective: To develop students' leadership skills as well as receiving the feedback from students.

Student representative must be:

- Have good conduct and behavior.
- 2. Not previously given administrative warnings in his/her academic file.
- 3. Commit to attend all lectures, laboratories and educational sessions.
- 4. Commit to conveying the opinions of all students impartially, credibly and without prejudice.
- 5. Have good communication skills.
- 6. Have good academic level.
- Not previously elected.

Conditions for obtaining a certificate of good conduct and behavior:

- 1. Never breached the university's ethical charter.
- 2. Not previously violated the Faculty code of conduct.
- 3. Not have a history of verbal or physical violence on the university campus.
- Not have a proven complaint from his colleagues, faculty members, or employees of the faculty or university administration.
- 5. Not to be in an existing investigation session.
- 6. Not have been previously convicted of theft or cheating in any of the educational activities.

Roles of the student representative:

- 1. Conveying ideas and participate in decision-making.
- Representing students in specific meetings of the Faculty Council and Committees when needed.
- 3. Developing ethical values and working in the spirit of one team
- Motivating students to contribute to the faculty's marketing, scientific, research and community activities.
- 5. Educate and supervise students regarding the annual elections.

Student Representative Code of Conduct:

- Represent students in a reasonable, responsible, and professional manner at all times, both personally
 and professionally, inside and outside the university.
- Treat others with respect, dignity, integrity, without unfairness or unlawful discrimination, and do not stop others with violent language, non-social or discriminatory behavior.

- Not to engage in any activity or behavior that is likely to harm the reputation of students or the university.
- 4. Not to use unofficial lists, signatures, and forms for any purpose that interferes with the educational process and the university's reputation.
- 5. Effectively support the goals and roles of the student representative.
- Commitment to all faculty council decisions and recommendations and student representatives'
 meetings.
- 7. Supporting and respecting the democratic process.
- 8. Treat the environment, facilities, and property with respect.
- Commitment to neutrality and permitting the reciprocal participation of others in the activities or services of the university.
- 10. Transparency in conveying ideas, requirements, and opinions, and carrying out duties and responsibilities as a student representative.
- 11. Use the faculty resources in a responsible and honest manner.

Mechanism for selecting a representative:

- 1. The committee undertakes a comprehensive education process in the electoral process.
- 2. All students who meet the conditions are allowed to nominate themselves.
- 3. The student must bring the required documents within the specified and announced period by uploading the documents on Moodle:
 - a. The nomination form for a representative of the students
 - b. A letter of good conduct and behavior from the faculty registrar.
 - c. Curriculum vitae form.
- 4. After closing the application period, the names of the candidates will be announced on the Moodle and the faculty Facebook page.
- 5. The announced students will present a presentation and talk about his biography, vision and goals.
- The committee will determine the time and place to conduct the election process for all batches. After the voting is completed, the committee will announce the winning name.
- 7. The winning student receives a form (Students representatives Guide) to help him accomplish their tasks.
- 8. Students have the right to object to the voting results by filling out an appeal form within an 15 minutes after voting.
- 9. In the event that there are reasons that hinder the student's work as a student representative (the presence of an administrative warning, withdrawal, suspension of registration, dropping out of studies), the committee conducts a quick election process so that students can choose another representative.
